Miami Springs

General Election

Any person who shall be a qualified elector of the city and who shall have resided in the City of Miami Springs for a minimum of six months prior to the day on which the said person seeks to qualify as a candidate for the office of Council member or Mayor shall be qualified as a candidate to seek office of Council member or Mayor.....[Miami Springs Charter §3.04(1)]

*The **Miami Springs General Election** will be held on **Tuesday, April 2, 2019.***

The candidate for Mayor and the candidate for each Councilmember group receiving the highest number of votes in the General Election shall be declared to be elected to office upon the canvassing of the certified election results. [Miami Springs Charter 3.06(5)]

Special Meeting. *The City Council shall convene a special City Council meeting on the night following the certification of the results of each City Council election or as soon as practicable within seven days of the certification of the election results. The special meeting shall be scheduled by the City Clerk after determining the availability and preference of the newly elected City Council members.*

Purpose of Meeting. *The purpose of the special City Council meeting is to receive and canvass the certified election results and to swear in and install the newly elected Mayor and City Council members into office.*

[Code Ordinance §11-03 (C)]

Installation into office. *The City Clerk, or any other duly elected or appointed judge or other governmental official of the State of Florida, may administer the oath of office provided in Charter Section 8.05 in order to install any newly elected officials into office.*
